- 1) Participants are expected and obliged to obey the laws of the Republic of Poland while participating in the event.
- 2) The organizers do not provide liability insurance for the protection of individuals or groups who participate in the conference.
- 3) Each individual and group agreeing to these Terms and Conditions releases and discharges the organizers, partners of the organizers, as well as staff of the event, jointly and severally from;
  - a. any and all actions, causes of actions, claims, liabilities, costs, obligations and demands, including without limitation attorneys' fees and expenses for, upon or by reason of loss, damage, injury, or death, which hereafter may be sustained by participating in any activities connected with the event. - 1) Participants of the session are allowed to bring alcoholic drinks with lower than 15% alcoholic content (such as beer or wine) to serve at their Eurovillage table. Lower alcohol content drinks will also be served at some of the session events. The EYP frowns upon overindulgence; any overindulgence in alcohol will result in session participants being sent home at their own expense. E.g. open containers of alcohol may not be carried around in committee rooms and hallways at the conference venue.
- 2) The EYP operates a zero tolerance policy on drugs. The European Youth Parliament will not tolerate any drug usage or carrying. Anyone using drugs or holding possession of them will be removed from the session and sent home at their own expense. The organizers will also inform delegates emergency contact immediately. Any possession of drugs will be reported to the police.
- 3) Delegates are not permitted to smoke inside the conference venue.
- 4) Liability of the organizers for all delegations' actions, results of actions and etc. related to the consumption of alcohol is stated in the section Liability.

Furthermore, organizers are not liable for any and all actions of underage delegations during the conference, the associated social events, especially if related to the consumption of alcohol at any point during the event.
